



Digital Millennium Copyright Act (DMCA) Notice and Takedown Policy

Lubrizol Employees' Credit Union is committed to respecting the intellectual property, privacy, and legal rights of others. If you believe that any content appearing on our website, online banking platform, or other digital channels is inaccurate, infringes your copyright or trademark, is defamatory, or otherwise violates the law, you may submit a written notice to us for prompt review and appropriate action.

How to Submit a Notice

Your notice must include:

1. Your full name, company (if applicable), and contact information (email, phone, mailing address).
2. A clear description of the content you believe is infringing, libelous, or illegal, including the exact URL where it appears.
3. The reason you believe the content should be removed (e.g., copyright infringement, defamation, privacy violation).
4. A statement that you have a good-faith belief that the reported content is unlawful or violates your rights.
5. A statement, under penalty of perjury, that the information in your notice is accurate and that you are authorized to act on behalf of the rights owner (if applicable).
6. Your signature (physical or electronic).
